- ▶ Private Parties
- ▶ Gang Exploitation
- ▶ Sex Tourism
- ▶ Acts of Survival Sex
- ▶ Selling of goods used for sexual content, gratification
- ▶ Fetish Services

CSE and SE Comparison and Intersection

- ▶ **Commercial Sexual Exploitation (CSE)**
- ▶ Comprises sexual abuse and remuneration in money, goods, or services- or the promise of money, goods and services- to an individual or third party
- ▶ **Sexual Exploitation (SE)**
- ▶ An unfair imbalance in power between two or more people person for the purpose of sexual pleasure.
- ▶ Can comprise sexual abuse and remuneration in money goods, or services- or the promise of money, goods and services directly to an individual.

- ▶ Run Away/ "Throwaway"/ Homeless Youth
- ▶ Sexual Abuse/Physical Abuse/Neglect
- ▶ LGBTQ Identification
- ▶ Substance Abuse
- ▶ Poverty/Inaccessibility of Legal Economy
- ▶ Exposure to Violence
- ▶ Street Involved Culture/Economy
- ▶ Access to Technology
- ▶ Attachment to Consumerism, Inability to access these goods
- ▶ Development/Learning Disabilities
- ▶ Substance Abuse
- ▶ Poverty/Inaccessibility of Legal Economy

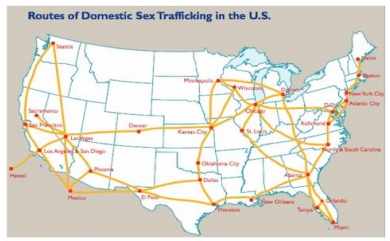
Gang Trafficking:

- ▶ Victims stay within click

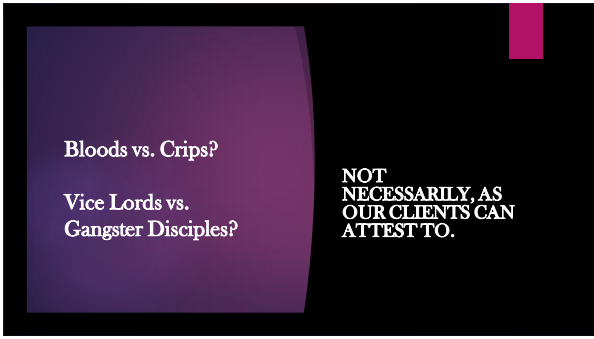
Familial Trafficking:
